FINANCIAL REPORT:

- Removing \$6,459.70 of income (Grant & Hospice) we made an operating loss for July of \$3,196.92.
- YTD our adjusted* Net Profit result remains positive at \$12,269.71 (*\$11,000 deducted for Hospice & Grant).
- The COVID Resurgence Payment continues to cover our monthly net losses.
- Next year will be financially challenging if we can't get Table Money income up.
